Regulations

ALL SSHBEA RULES APPLY IN ALL CLASSES

*** ALL HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH SSHBEA & ALL HORSES MUST BE RECORDED IN THE CORRECT OWNERS NAME**

ALL AMATEUR (RIDERS 18 YEARS & OVER) MUST HAVE A SSHBEA AMATEUR CARD - *Exhibitors 17 & Under are not required to have an amateur card.*

ALL TRAINERS (RIDERS 18 YEARS & OVER) MUST HAVE A PSSHTA (TRAINER) CARD

***AMATEUR OWNED & TRAINED CLASSES** - One in which every contestant is either an "Amateur" who owns the entry being shown or is an amateur member of owner's immediate family.

*Dues must be paid in Ladies Auxiliary and Youth Council and all requirements must be met to show in these classes.

*Men's and Ladies designated classes are for riders 18 years and over.

*A negative coggins is required on all horses entering the show grounds.

*Trail Pleasure Classes – shoe not to exceed ¾" wide x 7/16 inch thick. The caulk cannot exceed 1 inch (**measured from the turn back**)

*Lite Shod Classes – shoe must not exceed 1 inch wide x ½ in. thick. The caulk cannot exceed 1 inch and turn back shall not exceed 1 inch.

*Open Shod Classes – shoe must not exceed 1 ½ in. wide x ½ in. thick. The caulk cannot exceed 1 inch and turnback shall not exceed 1 inch.

*Country Trail Pleasure & Traditional Trail Pleasure – manufactured stamped cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 x ¾ inches and toe must not exceed 4 inches.

WORKOUTS – Rule 12.29 (page39) A workout must be held if there are 22 or more entries.

SPLIT CLASSES -- Rule 9.2 BB (page 26) To split classes in which entries total 35 or greater.

SPECIAL NOTICE – PLEASE READ

PRIZE MONEY will be 40% of entry fees if 5 or more entries in the class. If 4 or fewer entries in class there will be no prize money.

Belt Buckles: Will be presented in the 5 World Grand Championship classes. If a person wins a preliminary or grand championship class, they may order a buckle after the fall show by contacting the SSHBEA office by October 17.

ENTRY FEES:

All classes except #83 & #86 and Championship Classes: \$20

Prize Money: 1st – 5th – 40% of entry fees, R,R,R,R,R,R

If there are 5 or more entries in the classes

Exception: Classes #83 and #86 – NO ENTRY FEE – TROPHY AND RIBBON TO ALL ENTRIES

ENTRY FEES – GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES - \$40

Prize Money: 1st – 5th – 40% of entry fees, R,R,R,R,R,R,

If there are 5 or more entries in the classes

WORLD GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES "MUST" QUALIFY AS FOLLOWS:

112 - #9, #17 & #60 113 - #8, #16, #42 & #79 114 - #8, #22, #51

115, #8, #21, #22, & #51 117 – #8, #21, #22, #25, #33 & #52.

ENTRY FEE: \$100

PRIZE MONEY: 1st – 5th - 40% of entry fees, R,R,R,R,R,R

If there are 5 or more entries in the classes

Breakdown of the 40% payback will be 30%/25%/20%/15%/10%.

*All Trail Pleasure divisions and Lite Shod horses are eligible to show in Open Classes.

*Anyone working out of a Trailer will be charged

*N/C – indicates NO CANTER - Canter – indicates WILL CANTER

*Classes designated 17 & Under, no stallions are permitted.

*Classes designated 11 & Under, no stallions are permitted.

*Classes designated 12-17, **stallions are permitted.**

*Children 11 & Under cannot show in classes where stallions are permitted to show.

*Amateur Owned & Trained must not have been professionally trained within the last 90 days.

Show Personnel is responsible for enforcing the SSHBEA rules and the USDA Operating Plan. Knowledge of the SSHBEA Rule Book will hopefully help you have an enjoyable show. It is encouraged that you are familiar with the SSHBEA Rule Book and any addendums.

Exhibitors are encouraged to read the following rules:

29.5D – Tungsten shoes will be illegal (banned) on Trail Pleasure, Traditional Trail Pleasure or Country Trail Pleasure Horses. There will be no welded caulks on shoes worn by a Trail Pleasure, Traditional Trail Pleasure or Country Trail Pleasure Horse. The shoes for these divisions cannot be made from any material heavier than conventional steel.

29.8 – No pads allowed. Exception: Corrective shoeing with a wedge and artificial hoof material shall be allowed in the show ring when applied to one hoof only, for the purpose of mending a broken hoof or hoof wall. Mended hoof must match natural hoof and the sole of the hoof must be visible.

GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

QUALIFYING GUIDELINES FOR GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: A HORSE SHOWING IN A 2 GAIT GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS MUST QUALIFY IN ANY 2 GAIT PRELIMINARY CLASS. A HORSE SHOWING IN A 3 GAIT GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS MUST QUALIFY IN ANY 3 GAIT PRELIMINARY CLASS.

Admission \$5

Children Under 6 Free

\$10 per horse/per day grounds fee---

Exception: No grounds fee charged if stalls are rented for each horse

Barn Area Parking Pass \$10 for the Show

Driver of Truck and Trailer Hauling

Horses is Free

Trailers are not allowed to be parked at barns

unless 10 or more stalls are rented. Trailers

may be parked in a designated area away

from barns used for the show.

If trailer is plugged into electricity there will

be a \$25 per night charge

Exhibitors working out of Trailer \$5 fee

and will park in designated Parking

in the Grass Area.

Stalls/Tack will be \$17 per stall/tack

per night or \$60 for the 4 nights.
