PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

1. Exhibitor and Owner must be a member of the SSHBEA.
2. Nomination fee of \$10 per Category, per horse. This supports awards and offsets some of the expenses.
3. Horses must be SSHBEA registered.
4. Only SSHBEA Affiliated or Sanctioned shows count in accumulation of points.
5. Accumulation of points begins upon nomination of horse (anytime after Nov. 30 for the following year's award). August 15 designates as cut-off date for entering high point for that year's awards.
6. Only classes designated "Spotted Saddle" will count for points.

S.S.H.B.E.A. HIGH POINT

“GENERAL RULES”

1. Points earned in Youth Classes may only be counted in youth categories.
2. Points earned in Model Classes will only count in model category.
3. Lite Shod classes may only count in Lite Shod category. Exception: Youth Lite Shod, which will only count in youth category.
4. Amateur classes may only count in Amateur category.
5. 14.2 & Under classes may only count in 14.2 and Under category. Exception: Youth 14.2 & Under, will only count in youth category.
6. Trail Pleasure may only count in Trail Pleasure category. Exception: Youth 17 & Under will count only in Youth category.
7. Horses may earn points in more than one category (in which nominated), but points earned in any one class may only count in one category.
Example: Points earned by a 2 Yr. Old horse in a Youth 11 & Under class may be counted only in the Youth 11 & Under class.
8. When number of horses is less than number of places tied, points earned shall be awarded based on the Total number of horses considered to “have shown” and judged in a class. First place will receive number of points as there are number of horses in Point Tabulation will be followed.
9. No points to be awarded if horse leaves ring before announcer dismisses the whole class.
10. Points are counted for horse, not exhibitor.
11. **Adult Speed Sport Horse – open classes only – Points counted only in Jumping, Barrel Racing and Pole Bending.
12. **Adult Agility Sport Horse – open classes only – Points counted only in Competitive Trail Ride, Hunting Horse and Trail Obstacle.
13. **Adult Cow Horse – Points counted only in Team Penning, Stock Yard Sorting, Shotgunning and Reining.
14. **Two Year Old Sport Horse – Points will count in Two Year Old Classes Only – Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Trail Obstacle, Competitive Trail Ride, Hunting Horse, Shotgunning, Jumping and Reining.
15. **Youth 11 Years & Under Sport Horse – Points will count in Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Trail Obstacle, Competitive Trail Ride, Hunting Horse, Stock Yard Sorting, Team Penning, Shotgunning and Reining.
16. **Youth 12-17 Years Sport Horse – Points will count in Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Trail Obstacle, Competitive Trail Ride, Hunting Horse, Stock Yard Sorting, Team Penning, Shotgunning, Jumping and Reining.

****SPORT HORSE “FUN CLASSES” DO NOT COUNT TOWARD HIGH POINT**
