Excerpts from SSHBEA Board Minutes on 1-7-05

Brenda Wright presented the Country Trail Pleasure specs again as follows: Two (2) classes at the Spring Show, Amateur (18 & Over) and Juvenile 17 & Under / the next class to be added will be Amateur Owned & Trained/ shod with a manufactured cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 x 3/4 inch / toe must not exceed 4 inches/ head shake not allowed and at any given show, horses in the Country Trail Pleasure classes may not show in the regular Trail Pleasure classes and Trail Pleasure entries may not show in Country Trail Pleasure classes. John Mohon made the motion to approve the above, Janice Higgins seconded, motion passed.

Country Trail Pleasure Gait description: A smooth easy gait with head motion **not allowed**.

To remain active in the SSHBEA Inspector Program, inspectors must pay their yearly dues and also pay the \$5 yearly renewal fee.

ALL HORSES MUST BE SSHBEA REGISTERED TO SHOW

Trainers must have current "PSSHTA" trainer card. Amateurs must have current SSHBEA Amateur Card.

Youth may show in all classes except those designed mens and ladies. Men's and Ladies Classes are 18 Years & Over.

Youth 17 Years & Under Do Not Have To Purchase An Amateur Card. Youth & Amateur Onwed & Trained **MUST NOT HAVE** Been

Professionally Trained Within The Last 90 Days. 17 & Under - **NO STALLIONS PERMITTED.**

AMATEUR OWNED & TRAINED CLASS: Is one in which every contestant is either an amateur who owns the entry being shown, or is an Amateur Member of owner's immediate family.

Country Trail Pleasure Classes may not show in regular Trail Pleasure classes and Trail Pleasure entries may not show in Country Trail Pleasure classes. Head shake not allowed at any given show.

ENTRY FEES: All classes (except #40 & #61) \$15

PRIZE MONEY: \$40, \$30, \$20, \$15, \$10, R, R, R

CLASS 40 - No Entry Fee (Ribbons to all Entries)

CLASS 61 - Entry Fee \$25

PRIZE MONEY: \$100, \$75, \$50, \$40, \$30, R, R, R

Trail Pleasure (Keg Shod) - Shoe may not exceed 3/4" wide & 3/8" thick. Caulk can be 1", measured from the back of the shoe.

Open Shod Shoe - Must not exceed 1 1/2" wide by 1/2" thick with the exception of caulk which must be no thicker than 1" and the turnback which shall not exceed 1".

Lite Shod Shoe - May not exceed 1" wide x 3/8" thick with the exception of caulk which must be not thicker than 3/4" and the turnback which shall not exceed 3/4".

Country Trail Pleasure - Manufactured cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8" x 3/4" and toe must not exceed 4 inches.

PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

1. Exhibitor and Owner must be a member of the SSHBEA.
2. Nomination fee of \$10 per Category, per horse. This supports awards and offsets some of the expenses.
3. Horses must be SSHBEA registered.
4. Only SSHBEA Affiliated or Sanctioned shows count in accumulation of points.
5. Accumulation of points begins upon nomination of horse (anytime after Nov. 30 for the following year's award). August 15 designates as cut-off date for entering high point for that year's awards.
6. Only classes designated "Spotted Saddle" will count for points.

S.S.H.B.E.A. HIGH POINT "GENERAL RULES"

1. Points earned in Youth Classes may only be counted in youth categories.
2. Points earned in Model Classes will only count in model category.
3. Lite Shod classes may only count in Lite Shod category. Exception: Youth Lite Shod, which will only count in youth category.
4. Amateur classes may only count in Amateur category.
5. 14.2 & Under classes may only count in 14.2 and Under category. Exception: Youth 14.2 & Under, will only count in youth category.
6. Trail Pleasure may only count in Trail Pleasure category. Exception: Youth 17 & Under will count only in Youth category.
7. Horses may earn points in more than one category (in which nominated), but points earned in any one class may only count in one category. Example: Points earned by a 2 Yr. Old horse in a Youth 11 & Under class may be counted only in the Youth 11 & Under class.
8. When number of horses is less than number of places tied, points earned shall be awarded based on the Total number of horses considered to "have shown" and judged in a class. First place will receive number of points as there are number of horses in Point Tabulation will be followed.
9. No points to be awarded if horse leaves ring before announcer dismisses the whole class.
10. Points are counted for horse, not exhibitor.
11. **Adult Speed Sport Horse - open classes only - Points counted only in Jumping, Barrel Racing and Pole Bending.
12. **Adult Agility Sport Horse - open classes only - Points counted only in Competitive Trail Ride, Hunting Horse, Trail Obstacle and Reining.
13. **Adult Cow Horse - Points counted only in Team Penning, Stock Yard Sorting and Shotgunning.
14. **Two Year Old Sport Horse - Points will count in Two Year Old Classes Only - Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Trail Obstacle, Competitive Trail Ride, Hunting Horse, Shotgunning, Jumping and Reining.
15. **Youth 11 Years & Under Sport Horse - Points will count in Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Trail Obstacle, Competitive Trail Ride, Hunting Horse, Stock Yard Sorting, Team Penning, Shotgunning and Reining.
16. **Youth 12-17 Years Sport Horse - Points will count in Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Trail Obstacle, Competitive Trail Ride, Hunting Horse, Stock Yard Sorting, Team Penning, Shotgunning, Jumping and Reining.
