S.S.H.B.E.A. 21st Annual Fall World Grand Championship Show September 24 through October 1, 2005

We would like to invite everyone to attend this great event that is only held once a year in Shelbyville, Tennessee. The home of the Spotted Saddle Horse Breeder's and Exhibitor's Association.

This year we will not be taking pre entries for the show, we hope this will allow more time to participate for our exhibitors without being rushed to make decisions for pre entries. All of the entries can be done at the show during the entry office hours. The show begins at 6:00 p.m. each night except for Sunday, September 25 and the show will begin at 2:00 p.m. on this day. The entry office will open at 4:00 p.m. each day except for Sunday, September 25 and we will open at 12 noon on this day. The entry office will remain open to allow all exhibitors to sign up for their classes. All classes must be entered 2 classes in advance. The SSHBEA business office will also be open during the day prior to the show. We will have the hours posted at the business office and the show office closer to show time.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES: These classes which are 3, 8, 16, 22, 25, 29, 67, 72, 76 are still nominated prior to show time. There will be no entries taken for these classes at the show. The nomination deadline is Aug. 31, 2005.

The fall class sheet is enclosed with this mailing. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the SSHBEA Office at 931-684-7496. Please read over the rules and regulations for showing.

Qualifying for Grand Championship Classes: A horse showing in a 2 gait grand championship class must qualify in any 2 gait preliminary class. A horse showing in a 3 gait grand championship class must qualify in any 3 gait preliminary class.



Cookout

The SSHBEA Annual Fall Cookout will be held on Sunday, September 25, 2005 at the show grounds at the Calsonic Arena. We will be prepared to eat at 11:00 AM. Please bring the whole family for this free cookout.



RV Parking

RV parking will be available in the designated area at the Celebration grounds. The fee charged by the Celebration is \$30.00/Day/space used. No reservations are necessary this is a first come first serve basis. The fee is paid directly to the Celebration as their employee comes and collects. All campers, travel trailers, mobile homes, buses, horse vans or trailers with living quarters will be required to use the designated RV Park and pay a fee. You will not be allowed to set up in the barn area.

Stalls

Barn Stalls/tack will be available on a first come first serve basis. The fee for a stall/tack will be \$18.00 each for a one night stall or \$125.00 for a stall/tack room for the entire week (8 days). You can call the SSHBEA office to reserve your stalls/tack. You will be responsible for paying for what you reserve. All barn stalls must be left the same way they were found. Any mulch, plants, decorative rocks, water fountains, etc. must be put on some type of removable plastic so the

mulch is not left in the rocks, and must be removed within one day of show closing.

Admission

Admission \$5 - Children under 6 Free
Vehicle Barn Pass \$10 - this covers vehicle into barn area only, does not cover admission.
VIP Pass \$30.00 each - This is good for admission for the complete 8 days.
Working out of your trailer - \$5.00



Misc. Information

No animals are allowed to graze in the field next to Calsonic Arena.
No animals are allowed to be tied inside the arena to the rails.
No dogs allowed inside the buildings on the Celebration grounds.
No smoking is allowed inside the Calsonic Arena.

Horse Registration

SSHBEA RULE #11.1 - IN ALL SPOTTED SADDLE HORSE CLASSES AT SSHBEA AFFILIATED OR SANCTIONED SHOWS, ALL ENTRIES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE SSHBEA.

All horses that show at the fall show "must" be SSHBEA registered. All horses must show under the correct ownership according to the SSHBEA records. If you need to register a horse with the SSHBEA, make sure all your paperwork is in order.

New Rule for "Pending" Registration

Effective with this mailing, paperwork that is submitted to the SSHBEA for registration, transferring, etc... that is not in order, will have 60 days to complete the transaction. After the 60 days, the paperwork will be null and void and the customer will forfeit what money was paid and all information will be discarded. If the paperwork is not in order within 60 days, you cannot show your horse under "pending" paperwork. We can no longer keep up with registrations, transfers, etc that is past 60 days old and we will not be responsible for the paperwork after this time. You will have to start your process over and complete the necessary paperwork and pay the fees over.

Rule Change: Rule 15.9 - Prohibited on the Horse for Western presentation:
Delete - A. Vinyl, rhinestones and patent leather

Sanctioned Show Fees

The fees to sanction spotted saddle horse classes with the SSHBEA are \$2.00 per entry. The SSHBEA Board voted that sanction fees for Out of State shows are not to exceed \$500 for the year. This will apply to multi breed shows only with only a few spotted classes and does not apply to affiliated (all spotted) shows.

"HORSE OF THE YEAR"

The deadline to nominate your horse for "Horse of the Year" is October 15, 2005. You can obtain the application forms at the SSHBEA Office by calling 931-684-7496 or you can download the form from the website at www.sshbea.org. The nomination fee is \$10 per horse per category.

ALL SSHBEA RULES APPLY IN ALL CLASSES

- * ALL HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE SSHBEA & ALL HORSES MUST BE RECORDED IN THE CORRECT OWNERS NAME ALL AMATEUR (RIDERS 18 YEARS & OVER) MUST HAVE A SSHBEA AMATEUR CARD

Exhibitors 17 & Under are not required to have an amateur card

ALL TRAINERS (RIDERS 18 YEARS & OVER) MUST HAVE A PSSHTA (TRAINER) CARD

***AMATEUR OWNED & TRAINED CLASSES**

One in which every contestant is either an "Amateur" who owns the entry being shown or is an amateur member of owner's immediate family.

*Dues must be paid in Ladies Auxiliary and Youth Council and all requirements must be met to show in these classes.

*Mens and Ladies designated classes are for riders 18 years and over.

*A negative coggins is required on all horses entering the show grounds.

*Trail Pleasure Classes are for Keg Shod horses - maximum 3/8" inch x 3/4" wide shoe.

*Lite Shod Classes - shoe must not exceed 3/8" inch x 1" wide.

*Open Shod Classes - shoe must not exceed maximum standard set by SSHBEA.

*Trail Pleasure and Lite Shod horses are eligible to show in Open Classes.

*Country Trail Pleasure - manufactured cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 x 3/4 inch and toe must not exceed 4 inches.

*Anyone working out of a Trailer will be charged

*N/C - indicates NO CANTER - Canter - indicates WILL CANTER

*Any Class designated 17 & Under "CANNOT" show a stallion in any division.

*Amateur Owned & Trained must not have been professionally trained within the last 90 days.

*NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED ON SWEEPSTAKE CLASSES: 3, 8, 16, 22, 25, 29, 67, 72, 76). All entries done prior to show. NO EXCEPTIONS.

***Yearling Sweepstakes - Halter Open (Class #67) "Step Up Class"** - Any exhibitor; the yearling must perform the step-up "show gait". Following conformation judging, the yearling will be called from the line up and asked to "show gait". Each individual entry will walk the length of the arena, turn and with a noticeable increase in speed "show gait" back to line up. The show gait will be judged 50% of the performance.

***Mare & Foal Class #109** - Mare and foal must be spotted. Foal has to be of weanling age. Entries in the mare and foal class shall be judged 50% on the mare and 50% on the foal.
