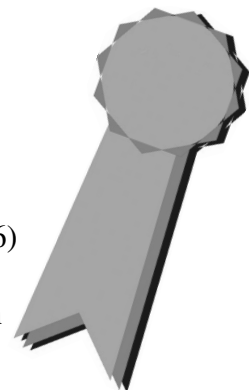

2007 Breeders' Cup Sweepstakes

The SSHBEA Spring Show will offer Sweepstakes classes for Trail Pleasure, Light Shod and Open Shod 2 Yr. Olds. Country & Traditional Trail Pleasure horses may show in the Trail Pleasure Sweepstakes class.

The following yearlings were nominated in 2006 and are eligible for 2007 2 Yr. Old Sweepstakes classes for a fee of \$25.

If your 2 Yr. old was not nominated for yearling sweepstakes classes in 2006, you may nominate it for a fee of \$100 at the Spring Show plus the \$25 entry fee. This will make your 2 Yr. old eligible for all sweepstakes classes through the 2007 season. You will have to pay the entry fee at each show and at the fall show in addition to the \$100 nomination fee.

"The Spring Show Sweepstakes classes will offer **"DOUBLE THE MONEY"** of the regular spring show classes.

"Open Books" for Tobiano Horses

Effective May 1, 2007 SSHBEA will open the registration books for registration of "tobiano" horses. This will remain in effect for one (1) year, ending May 1, 2008.

**Horses of unknown pedigree or horses that are registered with another association may be allowed to be registered during this time. If the horse that you are applying to be registered with the SSHBEA is registered with another association, the Certificate of Registration from the other association must reflect the applicant as the current owner.

Registration guidelines for this will be the same as current registration guidelines, with the exception of the following:

** No parent will be required to be registered with the SSHBEA.

** The horse can be of any age.

** Unknown pedigree will be accepted on both parents, but a video will be mandatory with the application for registration.

The fee schedule for this will be the same as the current SSHBEA fee schedule.

Trail Pleasure

Please read carefully, modifications have been made to Trail Pleasure with a new division being added.

All Trail Classes

Bits must not exceed an 8 1/2 inch shank.

No excessive reaching and/or pointing of the front end.

Country Trail Pleasure

Classes to be offered:

2 & 3 Year Old Amateur

4 Year Old & Over Amateur

2 & 3 Year Old Amateur Owned & Trained

4 Year Old & Over Amateur Owned & Trained

Juvenile 11 & under/not required to back.

Juvenile 12 to 17 Years Old

2 & 3 Year Old Open

4 Year Old & Over Open

Gaits

Exhibit a natural trail gait on a relaxed rein/**no head shake permitted**.

An exaggerated gait shall be penalized, i.e. breaking abnormally above level in the front end.

No excessive reaching and/or pointing of the front end.

Shoeing - Manufactured Stamped Cast Keg Shoe not to exceed 3/8 in. thick x 3/4 in. wide.

Traditional Trail Pleasure/new division

Gaits

Exhibit a natural trail gait on a relaxed rein/**moderate head shake permitted**. An exaggerated gait shall be penalized, i.e. breaking abnormally above level in the front end.

No excessive reaching and/or pointing of the front end..

Classes - Same as Country Trail Pleasure

Shoeing - Same as Country Trail Pleasure

Trail Pleasure

Change shoeing size to allow 3/4 in. wide x 7/16 in. thick.

All other rules remain the same.

No excessive reaching and/or pointing of the front end.

Note:

Country Trail Pleasure & Traditional Trail Pleasure will be allowed to move up to Trail Pleasure even at a one night show.

Country Trail Pleasure and Traditional Trail Pleasure will be allowed to cross over even at a one night show.

Trail Pleasure will **not** be allowed to show in Country Trail Pleasure or Traditional Trail Pleasure.

SSHBEA Rules

The SSHBEA is currently in the process of revising our current SSHBEA Rule Book. We hope to have it available for purchase soon. We have had some recent rule changes, clarifications and deletions. The following are some of the most recent changes.

Shoeing Guidelines:

The shoeing guidelines have been changed for Trail Pleasure, Lite Shod and Country Trail Pleasure. Traditional Trail Pleasure is a new division and the shoe guidelines are the same as Country Trail Pleasure.

Open Shod Shoe must not exceed 1 1/2 inch wide by 1/2 inch thick, with the exception of caulk which must be no thicker than 1 inch and the turn back shall not exceed 1 inch.

Lite Shod Shoe may not exceed 1 inch wide by 1/2 inch thick with the exception of caulk which must be no thicker than 1/2 inch and the turn back shall not exceed 1/2 inch.

Trail Pleasure Shoe (Keg Shod) may not exceed 3/4 inch wide by 7/16 inch thick. The caulk cannot exceed 1 inch. (Measured from the turn back)

Country Trail Pleasure - manufactured stamped cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 inch by 3/4 inch and the toe must not exceed 4 inches.

Traditional Trail Pleasure - manufactured stamped cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 inch by 3/4 inch and the toe must not exceed 4 inches.

Note: Country Trail Pleasure & Traditional Trail Pleasure will be allowed to move up to Trail Pleasure, even at a one night show.

Country Trail Pleasure & Traditional Trail Pleasure will be allowed to cross over, even at a one night show.

Trail Pleasure **will not** be allowed to show in Country Trail Pleasure or Traditional Trail Pleasure.

Rule Deletion

Rule 29.2 I and K on page 101 of the SSHBEA Current rule book will be deleted.

Rule 29.2 I - On the back of the shoe, the shoe cannot extend beyond the bulb of the heel when a perpendicular line is drawn from the bulb of the heel to the ground no matter what size shoe the horse is wearing nor what division it is competing in.

Rule 29.2 K - All shoe rules apply to all four (4) feet.

Rule Clarification

Mare & Colt Classes - Entries in the Mare & Foal class shall consist of a mare and her natural offspring, born of the year in which the mare is shown. The judging shall be judged 50% on the mare & 50% on her current foal.

2007 Hi Point

The SSHBEA has approved some additional categories to the Hi Point program and modified the "State Club" application to have a performance and sport horse division for youth and adult. Applications can be obtained on line at www.sshbea.org or we will mail you a form by calling the SSHBEA office at 931-684-7496.

Points do not start to accumulate until the application has been received by the SSHBEA Office, so the sooner you turn in an application, the sooner your points start counting. Please submit these applications directly to the SSHBEA Office.

"Double Points" - the SSHBEA board approved to have double points this year (2007), for outside affiliated shows.

ALL HORSES MUST BE SSHBEA REGISTERED TO SHOW

Trainers must have current "PSSHTA" trainer card. AMATEURS MUST HAVE CURRENT SSHBEA AMATEUR CARD. YOUTH MAY SHOW IN ALL CLASSES EXCEPT THOSE DESIGNATED MENS AND LADIES. Men's and Ladies Classes are 18 Years & Over. Youth 17 Years & Under Do Not Have To Purchase An Amateur Card. Youth & Amateur Owned & Trained MUST NOT HAVE Been Professionally Trained Within The Last 90 Days
17 & Under-NO STALLIONS Permitted

AMATEUR OWNED & TRAINED CLASS: is one in which every contestant is either an amateur who owns the entry being shown, or is an Amateur Member of owner's immediate family.

Country Trail Pleasure Classes & Traditional Trail Pleasure will be allowed to move up to Trail Pleasure, and will be allowed to cross over.

Trail Pleasure will not be allowed to show in Country Trail Pleasure or Traditional Trail Pleasure

ENTRY FEES: All classes (except #45 & #66) \$15

PRIZE MONEY: \$40, \$30, \$20, \$15, \$10, R,R,R

***Class 45** - No Entry Fee (Ribbons to all Entries)

Class 66 - Entry Fee \$25

Trail Pleasure (Keg Shod) - Shoe may not exceed 3/4" wide x 7/16" thick. Caulk cannot exceed 1 inch, measured from the turnback.

Open Shod Shoe must not exceed 1 1/2" wide by 1/2" thick with the exception of caulk which must not be no thicker than 1" and the turnback which shall not exceed 1"

Lite Shod Shoe may not exceed 1" wide x 1/2" thick with the exception of caulk which must not be no thicker than 1/2" and the turnback which shall not exceed 1/2"

Country Trail Pleasure - manufactured stamped cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 x 3/4 inch and toe must not exceed 4 inches.

Traditional Trail Pleasure - manufactured stamped cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8 X 3/4 inch and toe must not exceed 4 inches.
