- 1 Out of state horses must have current health certificate and IDOA permit number - to obtain call (217) 782-4944.
- 2 Current (one year) negative Coggins required. Must Present Original.
- 3 Classes subject to change. Please check show bill at show site for official classes.
- 4 Scratches must be made three classes prior to one being scratched to avoid being charged for class.
- 5 TWHBEA and SSHBEA registration numbers must be presented at show.
- 6 Single Registered SSH can show in all SSH, Country Pleasure and Versatility Classes.
- 7 WHOA Amateur Card Or Temporary Membership Required. Trainers need to present their WHTA Card Number.
- 8 WHOA HIO rules will be followed for regular classes.
- 9 TWHBEA Versatility rules will be followed for all versatility classes. Competitors are responsible for knowing these rules.
- 10 SSHBEA Rules Apply for all SSHBEA Sanctioned Classes
- 11 Youth Classes are for any youth 17 and under / IWHA Youth Program Classes are for Youths enrolled in that program.
- 12 Youth Riders 17 and Under are required to wear a helmet/Protective Head Gear / Helmets are encouraged for everyone.
- 13 Persons on Federal disqualification or disqualification from any HIO cannot transport horses to this show and can only participate as a spectator.
- 14 No Tungsten shoes or shoes with Tungsten added allowed in Country Pleasure, Trail Pleasure, Lite Shod and Show Pleasure
- 15 All Thrown Shoes will be Inspected and Weighed before a Class will be tied
- 16 Horses Cannot be transported onto the grounds with plastic wrap/ or allowed on the grounds.
- 17 No Action devices allowed on horses with the exception of Show Pleasure.
