To participate in the SSHBEA Hi-Point program a person must complete a Hi-Point application and pay appropriate fees. Accumulation of points begins upon nomination of the horse (anytime after Nov. 30 for the following year's award). August 15 designates as cut-off date for entering high point for that year's awards.
