No practicing or training in DECK area for safety purposes NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED AT ALL EVENTS

All SSHBEA SPORT HORSE rules apply in all Spotted classes. (This includes full western dress & proper grooming of horse-Rules 39.1 #1-For all competition; all contestants must use clean Western tack in good working condition. Horn on Western Saddle is optional. #2-Grooming, neatness and cleanliness of horse will be necessary).

Classes are for Spotted Saddle Horses only(exception-OTHER BREED CLASSES)-Horses must exhibit a Saddle Gait.

All horses must be SSHBEA registered and registration # is required for all entries except in OTHER BREED classes.

Notice-In all classes (excluding fun classes) a 5 second penalty in timed divisions and disqualification in untimed divisions will be assessed if the hat or helmet is not on the contestant's person the entire time the contestant is in the arena.(Hats held on the body by stampede string are allowed.)

For anything not covered by Sport Horse Rules-refer to the SSHBEA Official Rulebook.

Rulebooks may be obtained from the SSHBEA Office or viewed/printed from the website – sshbea.org.

<u>Sept 27 - Directions to CCWHA Campgrounds-From Woodbury</u>: Take Hwy 70S East, go 5.5 miles to Eastside School, turn left, go 1.8 miles to dead end-turn left onto Hwy 146, go 5.3 miles, turn left on road that forks off in a curve (Pea Ridge Rd).

Go .5 mile, take left fork in road (Big Hill Rd.), go .3 mile and turn right into CCWHA Campgrounds

<u>From Manchester</u>: Take Hwy 53 toward Woodbury about 18 miles-turn right on Hwy 281 follow to Hwy 70S and cross over 70S (this will be the turn at Eastside School in above directions) and follow directions above from dead-end.

Some classes may be split if entries warrant
All 11 & under participants ust wear helmets in ALL classes.
