PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

- Exhibitor and Owner must be a member of the SSHBEA. 1.
- Nomination fee of \$20 per Category, per horse. This supports awards and offsets some of the expenses. 2.
- Horses must be SSHBEA registered. 3.
- Only SSHBEA Affiliated or Sanctioned shows count in accumulation of points. 4.
- Points will start to accumulate beginning with the first show of the season and will be counted if nomination of horse is submitted by August 1. 5. August 1 designates as cut-off date for entering high point
- Only classes designated "Spotted Saddle" will count for points. 6.

1)*State Club Adult Performance 2)*State Club Youth Performance 3. *State Club Adult Sport Horse

4. *State Club Youth Sport Horse

Rules

- 1. All points in all Spotted Saddle Horse Classes earned in designated state will be counted. Ex: You can show Trail Pleasure, move to Lite Shod or Open, etc...
- 2. Adults will only get points in adult classes.
- 3. Youth will only get points in youth classes.
- 4. Points are counted for horse, not exhibitor.
- 5. Only classes designated "Spotted Saddle" will count for points
- 6. When number of horses is less than number of places tied, points earned shall be awarded based on the total number of horses considered to "have shown" and judged in a class. First place will receive number of points as there are number of horses in Point Tabulation will be followed.
- 7. No points to be awarded if horse leaves ring before announcer dismisses the whole class.
- *Each individual State Club will receive an Adult Award and a Youth Award. Points may be accumulated in 8. designated state only. Horses must be stabled or trained in designated state.
