AMATEUR CARD APPLICANT

Rule 2.3 Amateur Exhibitor - An Amateur for horse show purposes is a person who is 18 years of age or older on January 1 of the show season and has not engaged in any activities which would cause him/her to be classified as a trainer and holds a valid Amateur Card.

- Amateur cards must be purchased each year prior to showing. Cards are valid during show season of the year paid. Amateur card applications can be turned in at a SSHBEA show, at the SSHBEA office, or mailed to the SSHBEA Office

- A person who has previously been declared a TRAINER must wait three (3) years before applying and being granted SSHBEA Amateur Status. A Pro-Am form must be submitted.

Penalty for amateur showing without an amateur card:

- You will be notified by certified mail that you have shown without a card and you will automatically be suspended until card is purchased.
- Amateurs showing without cards will be publicized.
- The SSHBEA will not honor any other affiliating organizations amateur cards.

PROFESSIONAL TRAINER LICENSE APPLICANT

- *May NOT hold an amateur card.*
- By my signature on the application, I affirm I am NOT classified as an amateur and that I am a trainer of Spotted Saddle Horses.

COLT & HALTER LICENSE ONLY APPLICANT

- *MAY hold an amateur card.*
- By my signature on the application, I affirm I am NOT classified as a professional Spotted Saddle Horse Trainer and that I only work with equine under halter.

YOUTH CARD APPLICANT

- A Youth Exhibitor for horse show purposes is an individual who, on January 1st of the show year, has not reached his/her 18th birthday. (If an exhibitor is 17 on January 1st and turns 18 on January 2, the exhibitor is still eligible to show as a youth exhibitor that year.)

- A youth exhibitor may compete in an amateur class, unless the prize list specifies otherwise.

- Youth cards must be purchased each year prior to showing. Cards are valid during show season of the year paid.

Rule 17.4 A youth exhibitor (see definition 2.19) is declared to be an Amateur and is not required to have an Amateur Card which is an exception to 17.8 (*Exception: A youth whose parent is a Trainer cannot exhibit a horse in an Amateur Class if the Trainer has received remuneration for that horse.*)

- Youth card applications can be turned in at a SSHBEA show, at the SSHBEA office, or mailed to the SSHBEA Office.
