

Notes Rules

- ALL SSHBEA RULES APPLY IN ALL CLASSES
- ALL HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH SSHBEA (Exception: Speed Racking Entries) & ALL HORSES MUST BE RECORDED IN THE CORRECT OWNER'S NAME
- AMATEUR (RIDERS 18 YEARS & OVER) MUST HAVE A SSHBEA AMATEUR CARD
- **EXHIBITORS 17 & UNDER ARE REQUIRED TO** HAVE A YOUTH CARD
- **ALL TRAINERS** (18 YEARS & OVER) MUST HAVE A SSHBEA TRAINER CARD
- **AMATEUR OWNED & TRAINED CLASSES Ones** in which exhibitors are either an "Amateur" who owns the entry being shown or is an amateur member of owner's IMMEDIATE family. Co-Ownership between two non-related amateurs is not allowed in this class.
- Amateur Owned & Trained must not have been professionally trained within the last 90 days.
- Dues must be paid in Ladies Auxiliary and Youth Council, and all requirements must be met to show in these classes.
- Mens and Ladies designated classes are for riders 18 years
- A negative coggins is required on all horses entering the show grounds.
- ALL Classes will be required to back EXCEPT 11 & under, 17 & under, Tungsten Lite Shod & Open Shod.
- NO electronic devices allowed in any Amateur Owned & Trained classes (Exception: Youth Riders)
- STALLIONS are NOT permitted in classes designated 17 & Under or 11 & Under. Stallions may be shown in Youth 12-17.
- **NOVICE CLASSES** Amateur riders on Novice horses. If a horse begins the show as a NOVICE but wins a blue ribbon, it is no longer considered a novice & is no longer eligible for novice classes.

Regulations

- **Spotted Pleasure & Country Pleasure Shoeing:** Manufactured, stamped, cast keg shoe on all 4 feet, not to exceed 3/8" thick x 3/4" wide. The length of the toe must not exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". No welded caulks allowed. No Bands/No tungsten allowed.
- <u>Trail Pleasure Shoeing:</u> Maximum 3/8 thick x 3/4" wide with up to a 1/16" variance hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe (both front and hind feet). Borium is allowed on the caulks and toes of the shoe, but the thickness of the shoe, caulk and borium must not exceed 7/8" in thickness. Maximum 1 ½" turn back (measured from front to back of caulk). Clips are optional when drawn from the original steel, or poured. NO TUNGSTEN allowed.
- Classic Lite Shod Shoeing: Maximum 1/2" thick x 1" wide hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe (both front and hind feet) with a maximum 1 1/2" turn back (measured from front to back of the caulk). Borium is allowed on the caulks and toes of the shoe, but the thickness of the shoe, caulk and borium must not exceed
- $1\,1/8\text{"}$ thick. Clips are optional when drawn from the original steel or poured. NO TUNGSTEN or DOUBLE CAULK allowed.
- Tungsten Lite Shod Shoeing: Maximum 1/2" thick x 1" wide. Tungsten allowed. Double caulk steel shoe allowed.
- **Open Shod Shoeing:** Maximum 1/2" thick x 1 ½" wide. Tungsten allowed. Double caulk steel shoe allowed.
- Show Personnel is responsible for enforcing the SSHBEA and USDA required rules. Knowledge of the SSHBEA Rule Book will hopefully help you have a more enjoyable show. It is encouraged that you are familiar with the SSHBEA Rule Book.
